NEW BREWER'S JIG.

Strings.

Repeat.

1 and 2 and 3 and 4

BANJORINE POLKA.

$\frac{4}{5} = \frac{0}{1}$ and $\frac{2}{3} = \frac{0}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{4} = \frac{0}{3}$ and $\frac{2}{2} = \frac{0}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{1} = \frac{4}{2}$ and $\frac{2}{3} = \frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4} = \frac{1}{2}$

$\frac{1}{1}$ and $\frac{2}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{3}$ and $\frac{4}{4}$ and $\frac{2}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{3}$ and $\frac{4}{4}$

$\frac{3}{2} - \frac{3}{2} + 1$ and $\frac{3}{2} - \frac{3}{2} - 1$ and $\frac{3}{2} - \frac{3}{2} + 2$ and $\frac{3}{2} - \frac{3}{2} - 2$
