IV. ELETELEPHONY

Laura Richards (1850-1943)

PERFORMANCE NOTES:

The percussive or/and instrumental effects should be well projected and balanced throughout the piece.

The stems without noteheads indicate 'parlando' (pitchless speaking), with prominent theatrical prose-like style in hilarious and humorous mood. Also, theatrical gestures or dance-like movements underpinning the words and style are strongly recommended, if possible.

Higher stems designate rather the accented syllables than pitch change, usually accompanied by accentuation marks. Other percussive sounds (body sounds or hand percussion) could be used accordingly, provided they give way to the melody in the bass part.

Verbal indications are only meant to give a good idea of the desired mood of the performance.
