## About the artist

Composer, pianist and harpsichordist.

Graduated in pianoforte and in Classical Literature with a thesis on the Emperor Julian in Ammianus' History: the Campaign in Gaul; a research on the Roman Army in the IV century AD.

He composes studies and pieces for piano, polyphonic music for choir and orchestral ensemble, many songs for the theatre and for the school too; he makes popular songs and spiritual music arrangements with combine the original themes with classical music style.

He composes music using the texts of ancient Latin and Greek classical literature such as Vergilius and Homer, for choir and orchestra.

He composed some musical plays for soloists, chorus, and orchestra: LA TEMPESTA (2018) and SOGNO DI UNA NOTTE DI MEZZA ESTATE (2011), Italian versions based on The Tempest and A Midsummer Night's Dream by W. Shakespeare; IL SEGRETO DEL BOSCO VECCHIO (2015), inspired by the novel of the Italian author Dino Buzzati - with the original lyrics by Massim... (more online)
