**Comment:** The Bard of Armagh is an Irish ballad. It is often

attributed to Patrick Donnelly. He was made Bishop of Dromore in 1697, the same year as the enactment of the Bishops Banishment Act. Donnelly is believed to have taken the name of the travelling harper Phelim Brady. The English Lyrics read: O list to the lay of a poor Irish harper And scorn not the strains of his near withered hand But remember his fingers could once toil
