He wrote the solo cantata for soprano in Leipzig for a wedding and first performed it between 1738 and 1746. Bach used material from a Huldigungskantate (homage cantata), O angenehme Melodei, BWV 210a, first performed in January 1729 The piece is scored for solo soprano voice, flauto traverso, two violins, viola, and basso ...
