Comment:	Ach Gott, wie manches Herzeleid (Oh God, how much heartache), BWV 58, is a church cantata by Johann Sebastian Bach. He composed it in Leipzig for the Sunday after New Year's Day and presumably first performed it on 5 January 1727. He performed it again on 4 January 1733 or 3 January 1734. The dialogue cantata was composed for the Sunday after New Year's Day, probably of 1727, but the extant version is a recomposition from the early 1730s, which ... (more online)
