Comment:	Gott, man lobet dich in der Stille (God, You are praising me in silence) BWV 120, is a sacred cantata by Johann Sebastian Bach. He composed it in Leipzig for the occasion of Ratswechsell's inauguration of a new town council in a church service on August 17, 1742. Parts of the cantata appeared in a wedding cantata and a cantata (BWV 120b) commemorating the August 17, 1730. Bach reworked the choral second movement in 1742 (see this page online)
