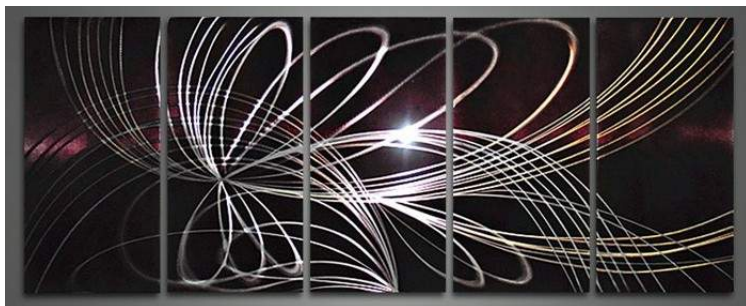
About the artist

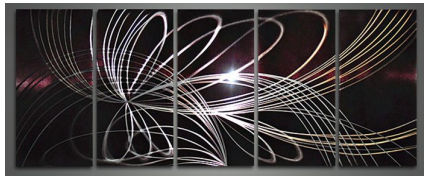

Comment:	Johann Sebastian Bach wrote his Fantasia in C Minor for String Quartet in 1704, though it was only published almost 100 years later. The fantasia movement has been cataloged as BWV 1121, and according to the Bach-Werke-Verzeichnis (BWV) numbered L. 138, and according to the Bach-Werke-Verzeichnis (BWV) named BWV 906. Bach was hired in 1703 by the Duke of Saxe-Weimar, Wilhelm Ernst, as an organist and conductor of the orchestra; he was particularly encouraged by the Duke to compose for the orchestra.
