Invention No. 3 in D Major for Viola Duet [BWV 774] Bach, Johann Sebastian Magatagan, Mike Public Domain Magatagan, Mike 2 Violas (duet) Baroque Bach's third exercise for his son Wilhelm Friedemann eases into the not terribly challenging key (only two sharps) of D major, but away from the strict counterpoint of the C minor invention. Here, the two voices are complementary but generally not canonic, except for an explicitly imitative middle section. Otherwise, the right hand presents a busy, wandering theme that the left hand supports with material




