**Comment:** The Prelude in C Minor (BWV 999) is a prelude, possibly for

solo lute or another instrument written by the composer Johann Sebastian Bach, probably during the late 1710s or early 1720s. The prelude starts in the base tonality of Dm. The D at the very start sets the mood. The use of a simple idea used to arpeggiate through the tonalities makes for the perfect masterpiece. The Prelude is constructed around 2 very simple
