Measures 1-5 of the first system. The piece is in G major and 4/4 time. The first staff (treble clef) begins with a piano (*p*) dynamic. The second staff (bass clef) provides harmonic support with chords and a simple bass line.

Measures 6-11 of the second system. Measure 6 is marked with a mezzo-forte (*mf*) dynamic. The piece features a first ending bracketed measure 10, which leads back to the beginning of the system.
