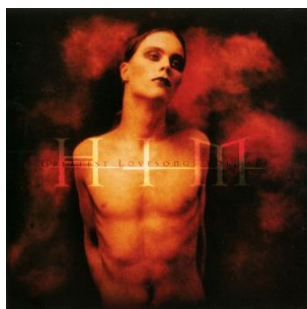

Detailed description: This system contains measures 8 through 11. The key signature is one sharp (F#) and the time signature is 3/4. The first violin (Vln. 1) has a melodic line with a complex rhythmic pattern of eighth and sixteenth notes. The second violin (Vln. 2) plays a similar but simpler pattern. The violas (Vla. 1 and Vla. 2) and the cello (Vc.) provide harmonic support with sustained notes and occasional melodic fragments. The harp (Hch.) plays chords in the right hand and a simple bass line in the left hand.

Detailed description: This system contains measures 12 through 15. The key signature remains one sharp (F#) and the time signature is 3/4. A 'rit.' (ritardando) marking is placed above the first violin staff at the beginning of measure 13. The dynamics for all instruments are marked 'pp' (pianissimo) from measure 13 onwards. The first violin continues its melodic line, while the other instruments maintain their harmonic roles. The harp continues with its chordal accompaniment.
