Comment:	Although William Byrd spent virtually his entire adult life in the service of the Anglican Royal Chapel, Byrd himself was a devout Catholic. Given the often violently anti-Catholic atmosphere of England during the composer's day, his choice to publish not only three full Latin Masses but also, in the shape of the two collections of Gradualia, some hundred-and-eight Latin motets designed for use in the Mass service, is remarkable for both its auda (more online)
