Organ

The first system of the piece, measures 1-4. It is written for organ in G major and 2/4 time. The right hand features a melodic line with eighth and sixteenth notes, while the left hand provides a rhythmic accompaniment with eighth notes and rests.

The second system of the piece, measures 5-8. The right hand continues the melodic line, and the left hand maintains the accompaniment pattern.

The third system of the piece, measures 9-12. The right hand has a more active melodic line with some grace notes, and the left hand continues with the accompaniment.

The fourth system of the piece, measures 13-16. The right hand concludes the melodic phrase, and the left hand finishes the accompaniment.
