Bassoon

The first system of music shows the Oboe and Bassoon parts for measures 1 through 4. The Oboe part is in the treble clef, and the Bassoon part is in the bass clef. Both are in the key of A major (three sharps) and 3/4 time. The Oboe part consists of eighth notes, while the Bassoon part consists of quarter notes.

The second system of music shows the Oboe and Bassoon parts for measures 5 through 8. The Oboe part continues with eighth notes, and the Bassoon part continues with quarter notes. The system ends with a repeat sign.
