Comment:	Luigi Cherubini's Requiem in C minor (1816) was one of the most highly regarded sacred works of its time, often compared to Mozart's Requiem in D minor, and admired by Schumann, and Brahms. Composed for the belated funeral of Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette, and performed at Beethoven's funeral, this Requiem is conservative in its scoring for choir, orchestra, and continuo; and...
