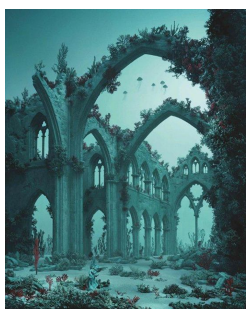
### About the artist

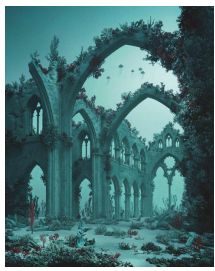
