## About the artist

Brother Evariste Ledoux Djontu is a religious of the Society of the Catholic Apostolate (Pallotin), born on 5 November 1977 in Bansoa.

A man of multiple graces, he is a self-taught of music and liturgical singing in particular. He entered for the first time in a choir in February 1998. He has never been to a music school. He learned through the choirs of Cameroon: Marie-Reine of the Universe of Nkol-Eton, Saints Peter and Paul of Mfoundassi, Way of the Hope of Nkol-Eton. He has enjoyed and continues to enjoy special support from certain choral conductors: Joseph Abanda (Guillou), Sidonie Kenfack, Doliris Miyono (Do), Francois Mbonjo Kiye, and others.

Singer baritone, he has several times presented the contest of song AGUIMUCLA, level I to level VI, under the direction of two great lyrical singers: Deschanel Chenko and Andree Balama. He is the author of several albums of religious music.
