Comment:	Mateo Flecha (1481 – 1553) was a Catalan composer born in Kingdom of Aragon, in the region of Prades. He is sometimes known as El Viejo (the elder) to distinguish him from his nephew, Mateo Flecha El Joven (the younger), also a composer of madrigals. El Viejo is best known for his ensaladas, published in Prague in 1581 by the same nephew. He directed the music at the cathedral of Lleida (September 1523 – October 1525).
