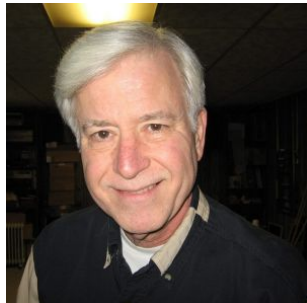
### About the artist
