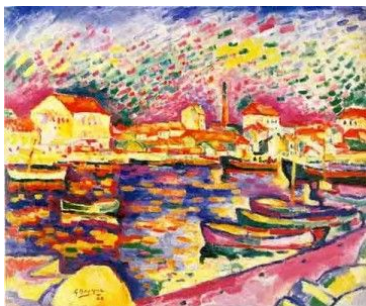

Morning Mood - Au matin
