Violin

Guitar

The first system of music shows the beginning of the piece. The Violin part starts with a whole rest in the first two measures, followed by a melodic line in the third measure. The Guitar part provides a rhythmic accompaniment with eighth-note patterns and chords throughout the first three measures.

The second system of music covers measures 4 to 6. The Violin part continues its melodic line, and the Guitar part maintains its accompaniment pattern.

The third system of music covers measures 7 to 9. The Violin part continues its melodic line, and the Guitar part maintains its accompaniment pattern.

10

The fourth system of music covers measures 10 to 12. The Violin part continues its melodic line, and the Guitar part maintains its accompaniment pattern.

13

The fifth system of music covers measures 13 to 15. It includes first and second endings for both the Violin and Guitar parts. The Violin part has a first ending that leads back to the beginning and a second ending that concludes the piece. The Guitar part also has corresponding first and second endings.
