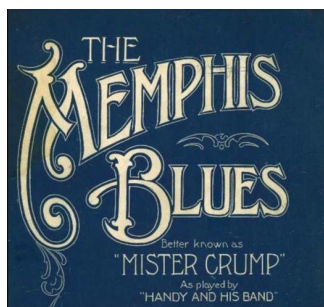

Tempo di Blues
