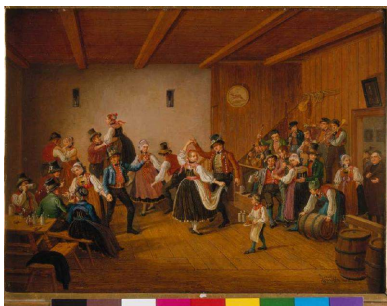

Orgue
