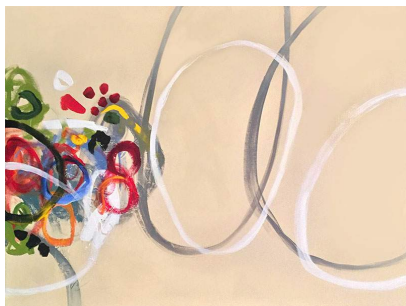
About the artist

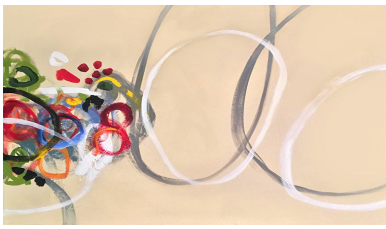

Comment: Giovanni Paisiello (1740 – 1816) was an Italian composer of the Classical era, and was the most popular opera composer of the late 1700s. His music was praised by Haydn and Beethoven and an operatic influence on Mozart and Rossini. Paisiello was born in Taranto in the Apulia region and educated by the Jesuits there. He became known for his beautiful singing voice and in 1754 was sent to the Conservatorio di S. Onofrio at Naples, where he studied...
