<b>Comment:</b>	Henry Purcell's birth -- 1659 is the accepted year -- practically coincided with the Restoration of the English Monarchy by Charles II after exile in France. Lavish court music in the French manner was to be provided by an enlarged royal musical establishment, of which Purcell became a member as a boy singer in the Chapel Royal. When his voice broke, he got a position as an unpaid assistant to the King's instrument-keeper and eventually succeeded... (more online)
