Joseph Ignaz Schnabel (1767 - 1831) was a German composer and church musician. Schnabel came from a musical family and was taught music early on by his father. As a child he was a chorister of the church in Wroclaw Vincent and attended by age 12, because he wanted to be a priest, St. Matthias School.
