## No. 1. "It's Funny When You Feel That Way."

Violin / Flute (Vln. / Fl.) and Piano (Piano) score for the first movement of the Medley Quadrille.

The score is in 2/4 time and begins with a forte (*f*) dynamic. The first system shows the initial melody in the Violin/Flute part and the piano accompaniment. The second system continues the melody and accompaniment, with a measure rest in the Violin/Flute part at measure 7.
