Harpsichord

Measures 1-6 of the harpsichord arrangement. The music is in C major and 3/4 time. The right hand features a melody with eighth-note patterns, while the left hand provides a steady accompaniment of eighth notes.

Measures 7-12. Measure 7 begins with a repeat sign. Measures 8-12 continue the melodic and accompanimental patterns, with some eighth-note runs in the right hand.

Measures 30-34. Measure 30 starts with a repeat sign. Measures 31-34 include a first ending (1.) and a second ending (2.) that concludes the piece with a final chord in D major.
