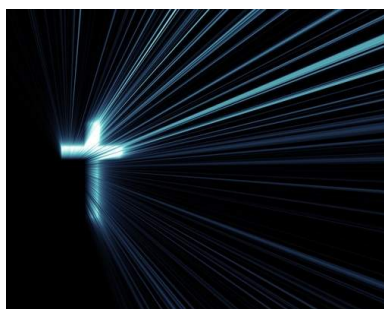
### About the artist

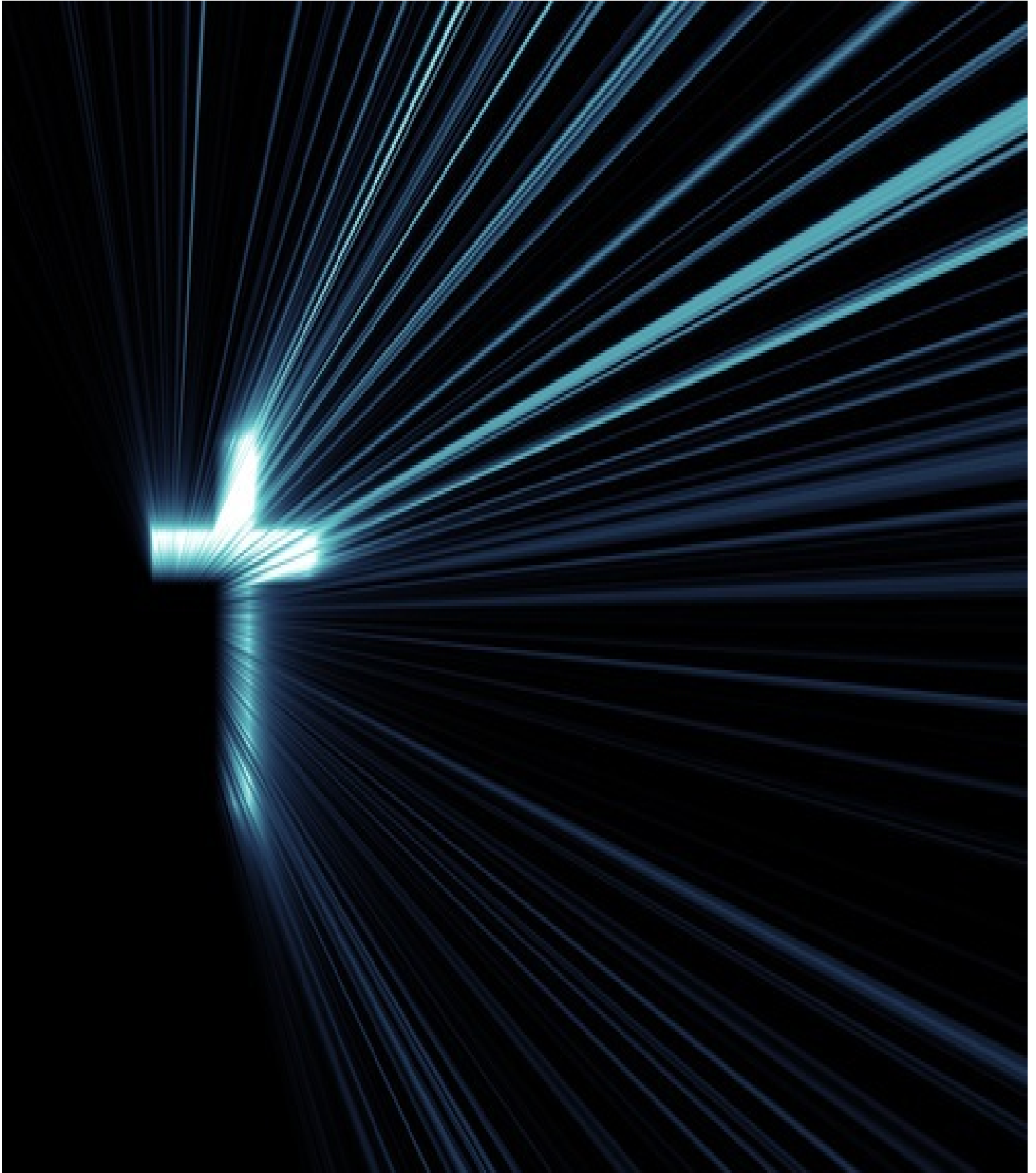

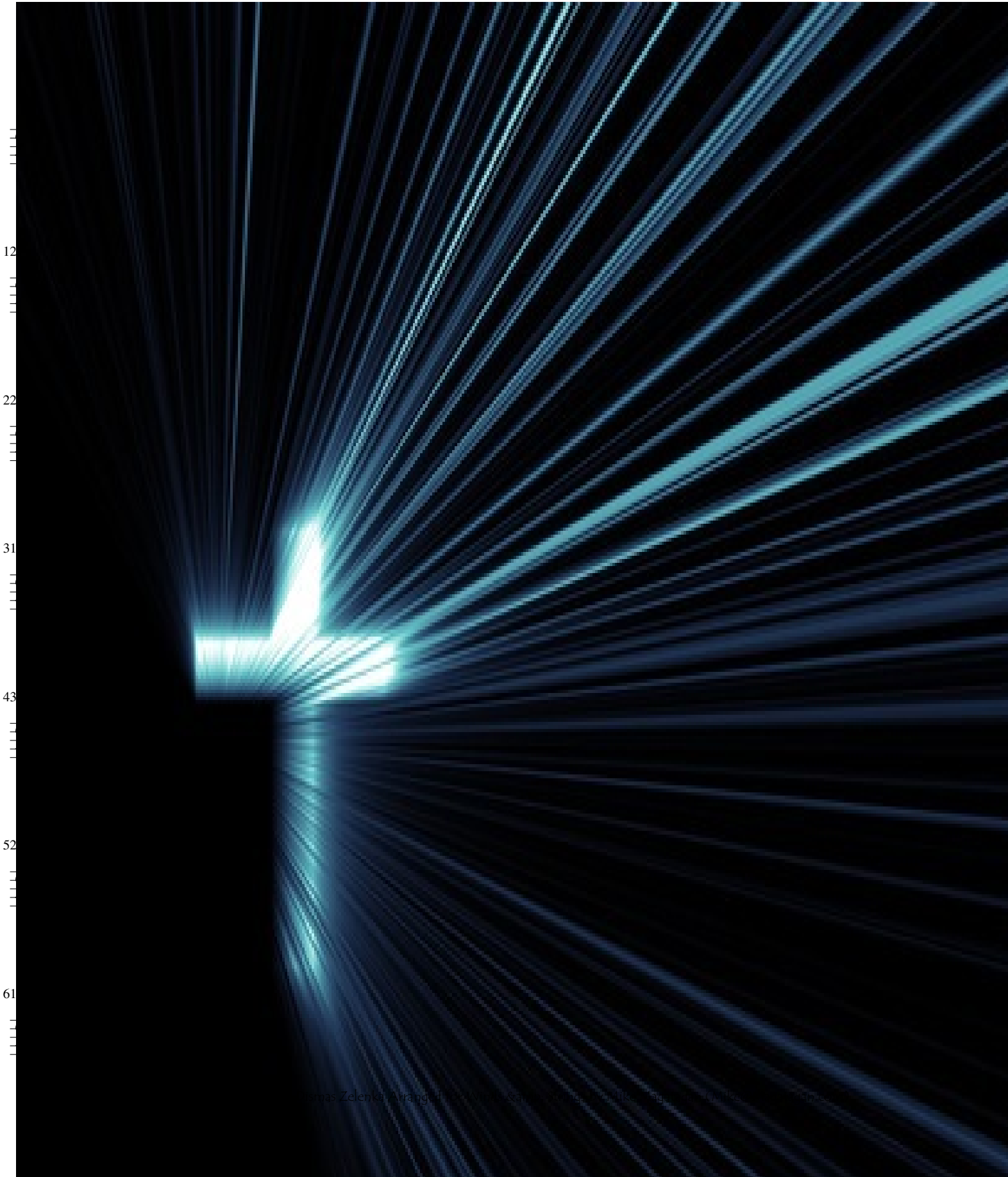
