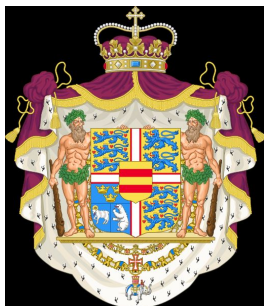

Rondo


