Kibira is a National Park in northwestern Burundi. Overlying 4 provinces, 16% of the park consists of montane rainforests. Water from the forests account for over 3/4 of the water that goes into the country's largest dam, generating 1/2 of the country's hydroelectric power. It is also the most vital park in the country for preserving montane-forest birds.
