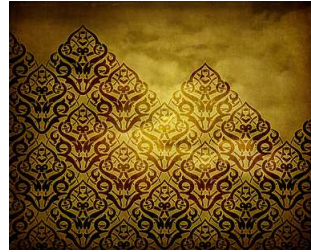


THE ALHAMBRA VASE
