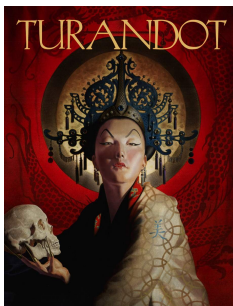

Andante sostenuto
