3bardelay A Curious Duet for two keyboards

When keyboards face each other, every key gives a different note from the one opposite. All except the D key in the middle.

To make the duet:

A Firstly, A begins to play the original melody.



After a 3 bar delay, B begins to copy, from the start, exactly the pattern of movements made by A ...giving an entirely new second melody to complete the duet.
