Measures 1-3 of the piece. The Soprano Recorder part features a melodic line with eighth and sixteenth notes, including a fermata over the third measure. The Guitar part provides a rhythmic accompaniment with quarter and eighth notes.

Measures 4-6. The Soprano Recorder continues its melodic line, and the Guitar accompaniment remains consistent with the previous measures.
